Enrichment Workshop Descriptions Session 5 2009/10

Cre8tive Corner IV	<i>This session in Cre8tive Corner we will be creating art using various methods, such as paper maché, stenciling, and speckled paint. Come and let your imagination grow as you learn new techniques and make unique art over the course of eight weeks. At the end of the session, you will be able to showcase your own art!</i>
LARP	<p>Wizards Warriors and You - Space Odyssey X1</p> <p>Have you ever wanted to seek treasure and un-cover secrets of the universe? Battle Bandits, Orcs, Space Wraiths or Ancient Dragons? Find your way through the dungeon and solve the puzzle? Now you can in a interactive theater world with wizards, warriors, space alchemist and Inter-dimensional creatures you can. Will you be Hero or Villain, friend or foe? Find the Philosopher stone and save the world or let the shadow of the great conjunction fall upon the land forever? Come create your own character and find out! The workshop ends in a LARP event at the close of Session.</p>
LARP Games	<p>A live action role-playing game (LARP) is a form of role-playing game where the participants physically act out their characters' actions. The players pursue goals within a fictional setting represented by the real world, while interacting with each other in character. The outcome of player actions may be mediated by game rules, or determined by consensus between players. **One must be in LARP to enroll in LARP games**</p>
FotoFive Club	<p>Go on exciting excursions and take pictures with real film! This class is limited to 5 people. We will be heading outdoors in this workshop to be inspired by different surroundings. Places we may go include Menotomy Rocks and Arlington Heights. We also will be using photoshop to edit pictures.
